Scholarship: We are pleased to be able to offer the **John C. Wallace Scholarship** to eligible students again this year! The John C. Wallace Scholarship Fund was established in 2017 by Carolyn Wallace and Ashley Borders to memorialize John, a longtime parishioner of St. Martin's Episcopal Church. The program offers two \$1000 scholarships each year, and it is intended to support post-secondary educational opportunities for members of St. Martin's Episcopal Church planning to attend an accredited two- or four-year community college, college or university, or a technical or vocational school in the United States.

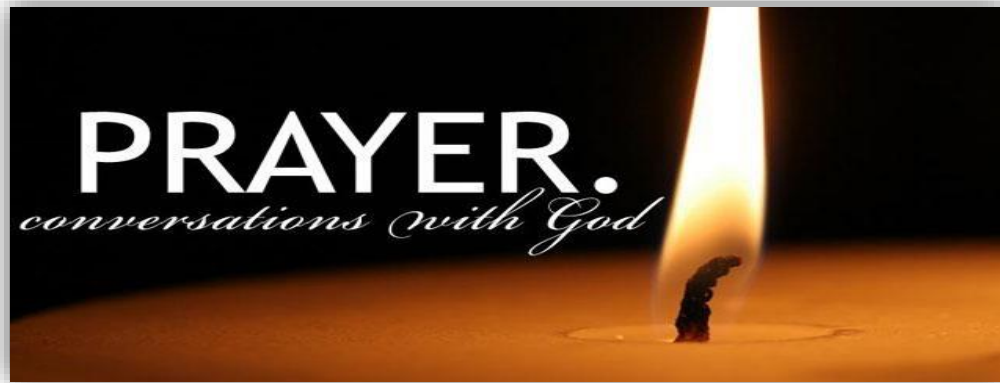
